2022 at 1:00 p.m. to review and discuss the proposed amendments. The meeting will be held in the auditorium of the EcoComplex located at 1200 Florence-Columbus Road, Bordentown, NJ. If emergent circumstances require, this meeting may be conducted virtually instead of in-person. Any changes in meeting location or format and instructions on how to view and participate will be posted on the County website www.co.burlington.nj.us/807/District-Solid-Waste-Management-Plan at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled meeting.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Burlington County Board of County Commissioners (the "County" or the "Board") will conduct a public hearing to consider an Update of the Burlington County District Solid Waste Management Plan and a proposed amendment to the District Solid Waste Management Plan ("District Plan") to include a Class A Recycling Center. The hearing will be held on Wednesday, March 23, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Commissioner's Board Room, County Administration Building, 48 Rancocas Road, Mount Holly, New Jersey, and will continue until such time as all comments by those attending have been heard in compliance with the Rules of the Board.

Immediately following the public information meeting, a meeting of the Burlington County Solid Waste Advisory Council (SWAC) will be convened to discuss the proposed amendments. The SWAC meeting will also be held at the EcoComplex unless otherwise posted at www.co.burlington.nj.us/1937/Solid-Waste-Advisory-Council.

The proposed amendments are intended to amend the existing District Plan only as reflected therein. Electronic copies of the proposed amendments have been posted on the County's District Solid Waste Management Plan webpage. Copies of former versions of the District Plan and amendments thereto were previously transmitted to all Burlington County municipalities and public libraries and should be on file for inspection at those locations. All documents relating to the current District Plan and the proposed amendments are on file and may be inspected in the offices of the Burlington County Department of Solid Waste in the Rutgers EcoComplex, 1200 Florence-Columbus Road, Bordentown, New Jersey. The purpose of the hearing will be to review the proposed amendments, to hear all interested persons, and to consider any and all written objections and supporting evidence that may be introduced as part of or prior to the oral hearing.

The proposed amendments may be summarized as follows:

AMENDMENT 22-1: The County has prepared an update to the 2009 District Plan to cover the ten-year planning horizon of 2021 - 2031. The Plan Update also includes specific information regarding the construction of additional landfill capacity at the Burlington County Resource Recovery Complex in Florence and Mansfield Townships (22000 Burlington-Columbus Road Mansfield, NJ 08022). Additional landfill capacity of approximately 7.5 million cubic yards of air space will be provided through horizontal expansion of the existing landfill on a footprint of fifty acres. There will be no changes to the landfill operations in terms of traffic volume, operating hours, and waste types accepted resulting from the landfill expansion. All solid waste vehicles accessing the Complex must utilize the mandatory access and egress routes. Vehicles must utilize Interstate I-295, exiting at Exit 52, travel east on County Route 656 (Florence-Columbus Road), turn right onto County Route 543 (Burlington-Columbus Road) and travel west to the entrance to the Complex.

All written comments, objections and supporting evidence pertaining to the proposed amendments must be filed by 12:00 noon on Friday, March 18, 2022. Final action by the Board on the proposed amendments may occur following the close of the Public Hearing on March 23, 2022 at the earliest.

AMENDMENT 22-2: Allied Recycling, Inc. has requested that the District Plan be amended to include the site of the existing Class A Recycling Center at Block 1201, Lot 2.01 (2658 U.S. Route 206) in Springfield Township. The applicant proposes to accept no more than 300 tons of plastic and glass containers, metal cans, paper and cardboard per day. Materials will be processed and may be stored onsite prior to shipment to market. Vehicles will access and exit the site via Route 206 north or south depending on origin and destination.

In addition to the public hearing, a public information meeting will be held on Thursday, February 10,


