WHEREAS, Job Skills training increases opportunities for individuals to obtain gainful employment and maintain independence and enhances their ability to be fully contributing members of society; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Burlington (the "Board") and the Burlington County Workforce Development Board believe that those who receive job training and the general public will benefit by the County's receipt of funding for job training for displaced workers, those who are economically disadvantaged, and other persons who satisfy the eligibility criteria, pursuant to the Workforce Innovations and Opportunity Act; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Department of Labor and Workforce Development, and the State Employment and Training Commission have established a New Jersey Eligible Training Providers List ("ETPL") of schools and employers that have been approved by the State agency having jurisdiction over their license and/or certification or by the federal government and are, therefore, eligible to provide training consistent with the Workforce Innovations and Opportunity Act; and

WHEREAS, the process employed by the State of New Jersey, by which schools and employers may be admitted to the ETPL is a "fair and open process" within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7, because schools and employers can apply to be on the list any time, eligibility is based on uniform standards employed by various State agencies for licensure or certification, and directions for admission to the list are on the State's website; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received a grant for the State of New Jersey to provide funding for the agreements with approved training providers; and

WHEREAS eligible persons in need of training have the ability to select the training provider and program from the ETPL that best satisfies their need; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement(s) shall be charged to the appropriate account number(s) prior to services being rendered and shall be contingent upon approval and receipt of sufficient grant funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Burlington, as follows:

1. The agreements referenced above between the Workforce Development Board, the County of Burlington, and the Eligible Training Providers for the term July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023 is hereby authorized subject to final approval as to form and content by the County Solicitor's Office.

2. The appropriate County officials are hereby authorized to sign, seal, execute and witness/attest the agreements in accordance with the Rules of the Board.

3. The Burlington County Director of Human Services and staff are authorized to take any actions necessary to implement the terms of these agreements.
