

Options for Old Round Recycling Buckets

Recycling buckets can not be used as a curbside trash container.

Municipality	What to do with your old recycling buckets
County-wide dropoff	Dropoff at the County Resource Recovery Complex, 22,000 Columbus Road in Mansfield, Saturdays 7am - 2pm.
Beverly City	Call 609-387-1881, X102 to arrange for pickup.
Bordentown Twp.	Bring to Public Works Garage, 266 Crosswicks Road, Hours: Weekdays, 8am - 3:30 pm, Sat. 8am - noon
Burlington City	Call 609-386-0200 ext. 124
Burlington Twp.	Bring to recycling facility, Lake Ave & Mill Road, call 239-5909 or visit www.twp.burlington.nj.us for hours.
Chesterfield	Stack next to brush recycling located behind the Police Department 300 Bordentown-Chesterfield Road during daylight hours.
Cinnaminson	Drop off at Public Works, 1601 Union Landing Road on Wednesdays, between 7:30 am and 2:30 pm.
Delanco	Bring to Township Garage, Coopertown Road, Hours: Weekdays, 7am - 3:30 pm.
Delran	Bring to Public Works Garage, behind Municipal Building on Chester Ave. 24/7
Eastampton	Dropoff at Public Works, 725 Smithville Road, behind the police station – Hours: 24/7.
Edgewater Park	Beginning Mon. Oct 27th, residents may use yellow buckets for yard debris or bring them to the Township Garage. Mon - Fri 7 am to 3 pm.
Evesham	Residents may use old buckets for small brush and twigs or dropoff at Public Works, 501 Evesboro-Medford Road, weekdays - 8am - 3pm, Sats. 8am - 1pm
Florence	Bring to Recycling Dropoff Center, Summer Street Extension, Mondays & Thursdays, noon-6pm, Fridays, 8am - 6pm, Saturdays, 9am - 3pm.
Hainesport	Drop them off at the new Public Works Building at 8 Oak Lane, weekdays, 7:30am - 3pm.
Lumberton	Dropoff at Public Works, 35 Municipal Drive, 1st & 3rd Sat. of each Month, 7:30 am to 1:30pm
Mansfield	Center behind the Police Station on Saturdays from 8:00 AM till Noon or brought to the County Resource Recovery Complex, 22,000 Columbus Road in Mansfield, Saturdays 7am - 2pm.
Maple Shade	Drop them off at the Municipal Garage, Rt. 38 & Cutler Avenue. Hours: Weekdays, 7:30 am – 3pm; Saturdays, 9am - 1pm.
Medford Lakes	You can drop them off to be recycled at the Borough recycling depot behind the Firehouse, Stokes Road & Lenape Trail – Hours: 24/7.
Medford Twp.	dropoff at Municipal Garage, Commonwealth Drive, Mon-Fri - 7:30 to 1pm.
Moorestown	Residents can use buckets for other purposes, except for trash or bring to Public Works, 601 East 3rd St. Weekdays - 8am to 3pm, Sats - 8am-noon
Mt. Holly	Public Works, 250 Rancocas Rd., weekdays 7am - 3pm OR The Burlington County Resource Recovery Complex, 22000 Columbus Road, Mansfield, NJ 08022, Saturday 7am - 2pm.
Mt. Laurel	Green bucket can be used for township collection of small yard debris, OR, recycle it at the Public Works Yard, off Midlantic Drive, behind the Municipal Complex - Hours: 24/7.

New Hanover	Neatly stack in recycling area of municipal parking lot, 2 Hockamick Road, Cookstown Hours: 24/7.
Palmyra Borough	Drop them off, at the Public Works Garage, #1 Firth Lane. Hours: Weekdays, 7:00 am – 3pm; Saturdays, 7am - noon.
Pemberton Borough	If you no longer want your bucket, come in to Borough Hall, weekdays, 7:30 am to 4pm.
Pemberton Twp.	Public Works Yard, 500 Pemberton-Browns Mills Road - Hours: <u>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday 7am to 3 pm and Saturday 8 am to 12 pm.</u>
Riverside	Public Works Garage, 300 Monroe Street only between 3 pm and 3:30pm Mon -Fri or the 4 th Saturday of every month between 10 and 2.
Riverton Borough	Drop them off at the Recycling Depot - off 3 rd Street, next to the sewer treatment plant. Hours: Weekdays, 7:30 am – 3pm; Weekends, 7:30am – 11am.
Southampton	Dropoff at Public Works Garage, 1905 Route 206 , Mon-Fri, 7am – 2pm NOTE: Do not dropoff buckets when garage is closed.
Springfield	No town bucket dropoff, residents can recycle old buckets at County Resource Recovery Complex, 22,000 Columbus Road, Mansfield - Saturdays 7am - 2pm.
Tabernacle	Residents may drop them off to be recycled, at the Municipal Garage, 163 Carranza Road Hours: Weekdays 7 am – 3pm.
Washington Twp.	Residents can dropoff old buckets at the Township Building, 2436 Route 563 on Tuesday evenings from 5:00 to 7:00 pm.
Westampton	Neatly stack at recycling dropoff behind Municipal Building, 710 Rancocas Road.
Willingboro	Bring to Public Works Yard, Industrial Drive, Sats. 7am - 3pm.
Wrightstown	Residents can use old buckets for cleanup of leaves and brush or recycle them at the Wrightstown Municipal Utilities facility at the end of Martha Ave. Hours: Weekdays from 7:30 am to 3pm.
