 Hours: Weekdays 8am-3:30pm, Saturday 1-4pm
 Township Residents Only – ID Required

Everyone must report to the office before placing of materials – NO EXCEPTIONS

Where to Recycle Computers & TVs:

Public Works accepts certain electronics; however, **NO old-style CRT tube TVs or monitors will be accepted.**
All computers & TVs are banned from landfills.

Do not set them curbside for trash collection. Contact your municipality or visit burlcorecycles.com for recycling options.

We are finding insulin needles on recycling sort lines – **PLEASE PROTECT OUR WORKERS!**

Safe Syringe Disposal Program –

Lourdes Medical Center (Willingboro) 609-835-2900, Virtua Hospital (Mt. Holly) 609-267-0700, and Virtua (Marlton) 856-355-6000 will provide syringe disposal containers for a one-time fee of \$10.

Otherwise –

- Put needles in sturdy plastic container
- Put a warning label on container “Used Syringes”
- Seal bottle tightly with cap and duct tape
- Put in household trash – **DO NOT RECYCLE**
