## RECYCLE:

Paper and Cardboard  
**EMPTY, FLATTEN AND FOLD**



**Plastic Bottles and Food Containers**

Empty and rinse containers.

**Glass Bottles and Jars**

Labels are okay!

**Metal CANS Only**

Empty, non-hazardous aerosol cans are okay!

**Cartons**



**SET RECYCLING OUT BY 6 AM**

*Metal bar must face the street.*

*If your neighborhood still uses buckets, see other side for details.*

## **DO NOT** RECYCLE:

**NO** hoses or hangers

**NO** hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes

**NO** foil items, bulbs, cookware, or window glass

**NO** motor oil, batteries, or hazardous items

**NO** plastic with a



**NO** Styrofoam

**NO** plastic bags or wrap

**NO** air pillows

**NO** needles

**NO** plant pots, trays, lids, or cups

**NO** shredded paper

*You can recycle rechargeable batteries at Home Depot, Lowes, and other big box stores.*



## PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

### NEW CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

We are finding hazardous materials hidden in cardboard boxes that residents set out for recycling.

For this reason, **CARDBOARD BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED AND EMPTIED BEFORE RECYCLING.**

Fold large boxes, like appliance boxes.

Do not use boxes to hold other recyclables.

Remove and throw away foam and plastic wrap.

### AND REMEMBER...

- Empty and rinse containers.
- Do not flatten aluminum cans.
- Do not recycle Amazon plastic mailers.
- Do not recycle hard back books.



**RECYCLING CONTAINERS ARE MUNICIPAL PROPERTY**

It is illegal to put trash in your container or move it to a new property.

*Due to a serious rise in contamination, recycling containers are subject to inspection.*
