SENIOR CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY STARTS APRIL 13

Burlco Sheriff Offers Free Classes on Six Tuesdays

Burlington County Sheriff's Department will hold its annual free Senior Citizens Police Academy on six Tuesdays beginning April 13 to increase the safety of senior residents.

The classes, which will be held from 1 to 3 p.m. at the Emergency Services Training Center in Westampton, will include information on home security, fire prevention, Project Lifesaver tracking program, defensive driving, frauds and cons, health issues, the court system, and emergency and 2-1-1 CONTACT help lines.

"We want to help seniors be less likely to become victims of fraud, violence or accidents by providing them with all the information and resources available for their protection," said Sheriff Jean Stanfield.

Seniors also will be provided with photo ID cards and receive a tour of the Public Safety Center and demonstrations on K-9 police dogs and SWAT.
