

Meeting Minutes of May 1, 2019

The Burlington County Tax Board meeting was held in the Burlington County Administration Building in the Freeholder's Board Room, 49 Rancocas Road Mount Holly, NJ at 9:02am.

Tax Administrator Dawn Gorman opened the meeting pursuant to notices advertised and posted in conformance with the "Open Public Meeting Act" Chapter 231; as well as read the "Open Public Meeting" Notice.

Everyone present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners Chatzidakis, Kennedy, Lamon and Summerville were all present for this meeting and answered roll call.

Re-Organization of the Tax Board:

Commissioner Chatzidakis made a motion to nominate Commissioner Lamon as President; Commissioner Summerville seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Commissioner Summerville made a motion to nominate Commissioner Kennedy as Vice President; Commissioner Chatzidakis seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Commissioner Chatzidakis made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 5, 2019 Board meeting, Commissioner Summerville seconded. Commissioner Kennedy abstained from voting, all other Commissioners voted aye.

Business before the Board:

Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to approve Resolution 2019-2, authorizing the Tax Board to strike and certify tax rates. Commissioner Chatzidakis seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to approve the Annual Meeting notice from May 1, 2019 through May 1, 20120. Commissioner Chatzidakis seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to appointment Dawn Gorman as the custodian of records. Commissioner Chatzidakis seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Administrative Report:

Tax Administrator Gorman submitted to the Board the trust fund balance, appeals filed and scheduling estimates.

Tax Appeals:

Motions were heard for the following Municipalities: Pemberton Twp, Medford Twp, Beverly City, Bordentown Twp, Mt. Laurel Twp, Burlington City and Willingboro Twp.

Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to approve all the municipal motions for unpaid taxes or failure to respond to chapter 91 income and expense requests. Commissioner Chatzidakis seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Tax Appeals were heard for Evesham Twp. Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to approve all settlement agreements. Commissioner Chatzidakis seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Public Comments:

There being no public comments, it was announced that the next scheduled Board meeting will be held on Tuesday May 14, 2019 in the Freeholder's Board Room 49 Rancocas Road Mount Holly, NJ at 9:00am. Tax appeals will be heard at this meeting.
