BURLCO JANUARY H1N1 CLINICS OPEN TO ALL COUNTY RESIDENTS

Eight Clinic Dates for General Population

Jan. 18 for School Ages at Burlington Center and BCC Mt. Laurel Campus

The Burlington County Health Department will offer free H1N1 vaccines in January for all county residents at the Burlington Center Mall on Rt. 541 in Burlington Township and the County Store in the Moorestown Mall (over 18) on Route 38 in Moorestown.

Clinic dates will include: Jan. 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, and 15 from 1 – 7 p.m. and Jan. 16 from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. A general population clinic also will be held on Jan. 18 from 1 – 7 p.m. at the Moorestown Mall for adults 18 and over.

In addition, two clinics will be held on Jan. 18 from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. for school-aged children who missed the vaccine in school at the Burlington Center (lower level, Sears wing) and Burlington County College's Mount Laurel campus.

"We encourage all county residents to get vaccinated and help protect yourself, your loved ones, and your community against the H1N1 virus," said Health Officer Robert Gogats. "Since the flu is unpredictable, it is prudent to get immunized now to protect against a possible third wave in the spring."

Residents are asked to visit the Burlington County website at www.co.burlington.nj.us and complete the H1N1 consent form online and print a copy to bring to the clinics. "For the clinics to proceed without delays, we are asking that every effort be made to complete the form online," Gogats said. If a computer is not available, consent forms can be completed at the clinic. (*more*)
