## **FIVE NEW H1N1 CLINICS FOR COUNTY RESIDENTS STARTING JAN. 20** **JAN. 18 MAKE-UP AND SECOND DOSE CLINICS FOR STUDENTS**

The Burlington County Health Department will hold five new general population clinics for county residents on Jan. 20, 21, 26, 27 and 29, in addition to previously scheduled "makeup clinics" for school aged children who haven't received the H1N1 vaccine on Monday, January 18 at the Burlington Center Mall and Burlington County College's Mount Laurel campus on Route 38.

Children under the age of 10 who previously received an H1N1 immunization will also be able to get their second dose at the Jan. 18 clinic if the first dose was administered prior to Dec. 28.

The times at both Jan. 18 clinic locations will run from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m.

"Our goal is to vaccinate as many children in this priority group as possible, with the understanding that those younger than 10 will need a second dose at least 21 days after this first dose," said Health Officer Robert Gogats.

Vaccination for younger children will require two immunizations, spread out at least 21 days after first dosage. The CDC's recommendation for youth vaccinations are that children receive one dose for age 10 and above and two doses for age 9 and below.

In accordance with CDC recommendations, the Health Department will hold a second dose clinic at the Burlington Center on Thursday, Feb. 25 from 3 to 7 p.m.

The general population clinics for county residents starting Jan. 20 will be held at the Moorestown Mall and Burlington Center from 3 to 7 p.m. The Moorestown Mall clinic will be in the County Store for ages 18 and older. (more)

Residents are asked to visit the Burlington County website at [www.co.burlington.nj.us](http://www.co.burlington.nj.us) and complete the H1N1 consent form online and print a copy to bring to the clinics. If a computer is not available, consent forms can be completed at the clinic.

The Burlington Center Mall is located on Route 541 in Burlington Township. The clinic will be held on the first floor in the Sears wing. The Moorestown Mall is located on Route 38.

The health department continues to encourage residents to follow steps to help prevent the spread of flu in the workplace, schools and community. In addition to receiving the vaccine, people should wash their hands frequently, cover coughs and sneezes, and stay home from school or work if sick.
