FREE H1N1 FLU SHOTS AVAILABLE FEB. 2 to 12

Six New Dates at Burlington Center and Moorestown Mall

The Burlington County Health Department has scheduled H1N1 vaccination clinics for county residents through the first two weeks in February at the Burlington Center Mall on Rt. 541 in Burlington Township and the Moorestown Mall on Route 38.

The Burlington Center clinics will be held on Feb. 5 and 12 from noon to 2 p.m. and from 5 to 7 p.m. on the lower level, Sears's wing of the mall in the former Deb store. The population to be served at Burlington Center will be age 6 months and older.

The Moorestown Mall clinics will be held on Feb. 2, 3, 9 and 10 in the County Store near the entrance to the left of Sears. They will run from 12:30 to 2:30 p.m. and from 5 to 7 p.m. The population to be served at the Moorestown Mall will be age 10 years and older.

A limited supply of seasonal flu vaccine will also be available at both sites. Residents should visit the Burlington County website at www.co.burlington.nj.us and complete the H1N1 and/or seasonal influenza consent form online and print a copy to bring to the clinic.
