

- 1. Probate Information Sheet**  
Prior to coming to this office, complete this form and mail certified or FedEx with original Will and Certified Death Certificate. When documents are ready for execution, staff member will call and arrange appointment.
- 2. Administration Information Sheet**  
Prior to coming to this office, complete this form and mail certified or Fed Ex with Certified Death Certificate. When documents are ready for execution, staff member will call and arrange appointment
- 3. Renunciation of Executorship**  
If you are named in a Will as the Executor and you do not wish to act, this form should be used.
- 4. Renunciation of Administration**  
If you are the next of kin of an estate which is intestate (no Will), and you do not wish to act, this form should be used.
- 5. Renunciation of Right to Affidavit of Next of Kin**  
If you are the next of kin of an estate which is intestate (no Will), and you do not wish to complete the Affidavit of Next of Kin, this form should be issued.
- 6. Minor Consent for Guardianship – Person Only**  
If you wish to consent to the appointment of another family member to be the guardian of a minor's person only, this form should be used.
- 7. Minor Consent for Guardianship – Property Only**  
If you wish to consent to the appointment of another family member to be the guardian of a minor's property only, this form should be used.
- 8. Minor Consent for Guardianship – Person and Property**  
If you wish to consent to the appointment of another family member to be the guardian of a minor's person and property, this form should be used.
- 9. Refunding Bond & Release Form**  
In order to release an Executor or Administrator from bond, when an individual has received part of an estate, this form should be used. This form must be executed in the presence of a Notary Public.
- 10. Renunciation of Administrator Ad Prosequendum**  
If you are the next of kin of an estate which is intestate (no Will), and you do not wish to act on behalf of the estate for the purpose of a potential lawsuit, this form should be used.
- 11. Renunciation of Administrator and Administrator Ad Prosequendum**  
If you are the next of kin of an estate which is intestate (no Will), and you do not wish to act on behalf of the estate and for the purpose of a potential lawsuit, this form should be used.
