PerformCare helps connect children up to age 21 to the behavioral health, substance use, or intellectual/developmental disability services he or she needs to be well and thrive. Early Intervention Support Services (EISS) offers an alternative for adults age 18 and older who are experiencing emotional distress, but not in need of hospitalization.
