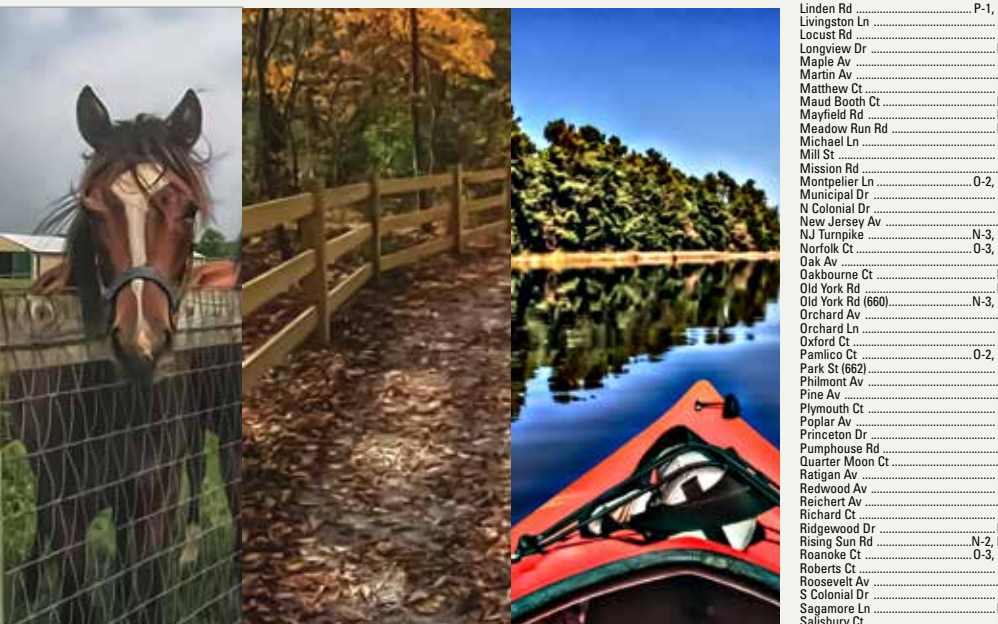
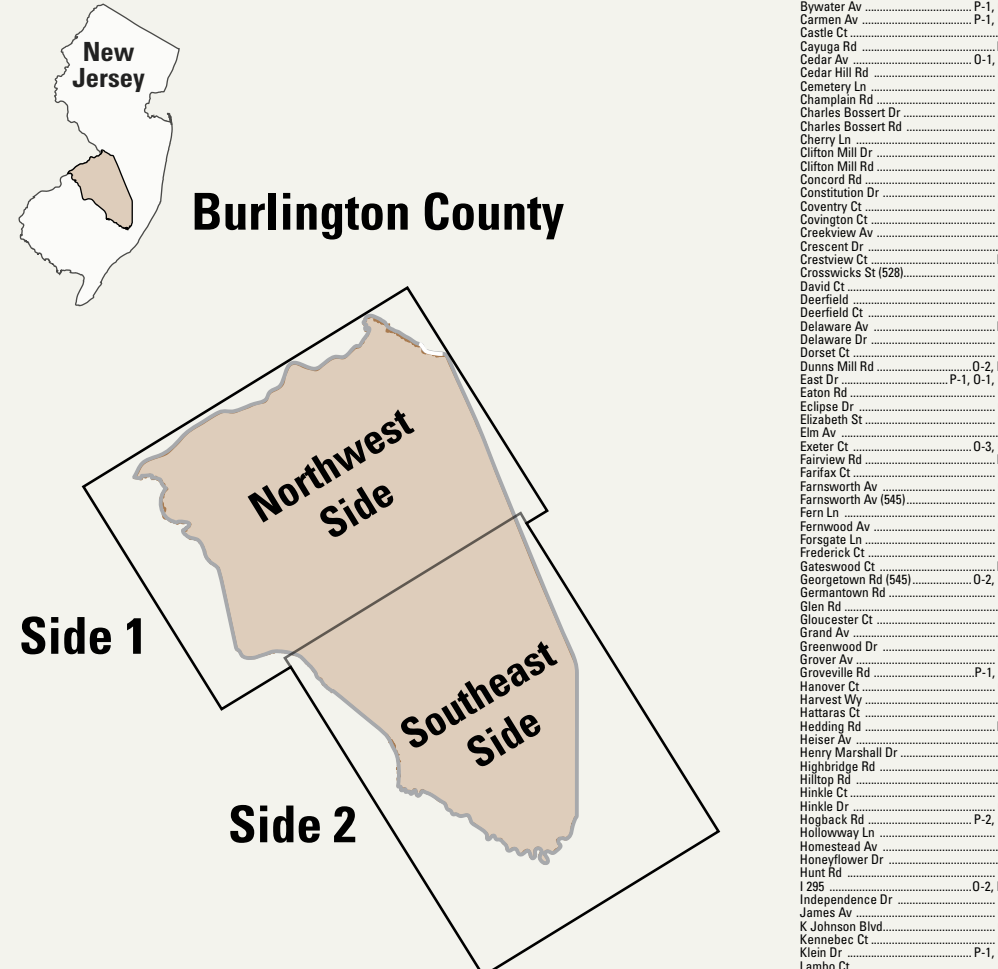

Welcome To Burlington County

Burlington County is the largest of New Jersey's 21 counties, covering 827 square miles extending from the Delaware River on the west to the Great Bay on the Atlantic Ocean to the east. The county is made up of 40 municipalities.

Burlington County continues to grow both in population and economically, with an estimated population of 445,953 in 2020 and 268,900 employed workers in 2014 and projected to grow to 222,400 by 2024.

The County remains a statewide and national leader in land preservation, with more than 62,000 acres of farmland preserved within the county, along with more than 1,000 acres of developed parkland. The County Parks System also includes several landmark historical sites, including the Historic Prison Museum in Mount Holly and Historic Smithville Park in Eastampton, adding to the wealth of resources that make Burlington County an attractive place for businesses to locate and expand and for families to live, work and play.
